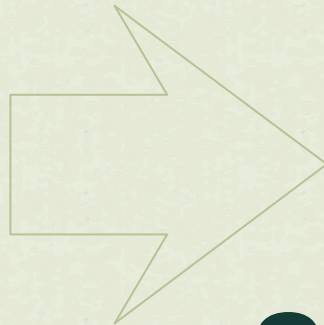
Climate Change: The Impact On Children
