
I te taenga atu ki te whare tiaki tamariki,

'No you didn't,' said Mary.


'Give it to me or I'll hit you,' said Bill.

Fai mai loa Pili, "Tu'u mai po le pini o oe."







‘No,’ said John.


‘Let me in or I’ll get you,’ said Mary.

'Hey! We don't hit anybody here,' said Mum.


'You can all show me inside the hut, and then it's time for tea.'


